## NHS Adult Haematology Antifungal Guideline For full guidance see Antibiotic website **ANTIFUNGAL** Primary prophylaxis depends on underlying risk and **PROPHYLAXIS** treatment (see full guidance) Itraconazole Liquid Low dose Ambisome IV Fluconazole If high risk of IFI: for ALL induction If having inpatient chemo but not at -Autologous HSCT for lymphoma <50kg 50mg 3 x week high risk of IFI including Autologous -ALL after induction ≥50kg 100mg 3 x week **HSCT** for myeloma This dosing is for prophylaxis only. - Severe aplastic anaemia Any patient who has had previous **Secondary** treatment for IFI (for 2 weeks or more) Posaconazole\* **Prophylaxis** and is receiving further chemotherapy If intolerant of itraconazole should have Posaconazole\* Pyrexia and neutropenia $\leq 0.5 \times 10^9 / L$ **INVASIVE FUNGAL** No response to antibiotics after 96 hours **INFECTION TREATMENT** Start empirical treatment: CASPOFUNGIN (Ambisome\*\* if drug interactions with caspofungin) **Investigations:** Galactomannan and ß-1,3 glucan testing on blood Are there CXR/CT chest abnormalities YFS NO consistent with invasive fungal infection (IFI)? **Stop** empirical treatment **VORICONAZOLE IV** (check pre dose levels day 5-7) and restart antifungal Isavuconazole IV if patient intolerant of voriconazole prophylaxis patient was Ambisome\*\* if patient on itraconazole or posaconazole prophylaxis prescribed previously Consider sending BAL for Aspergillus PCR - Contact Microbiology **MONITOR RESPONSE**

Step down:

IV Voriconazole → oral Voriconazole

Responding to antifungal and clinically stable

IV Isavuconazole → oral Isavuconazole

IV Ambisome → seek advice

## Dosing (assuming normal renal/hepatic function):

\*\*Ambisome IV – 3 to 5mg/kg od (start at 3mg/kg) Give 1mg test dose before each new course.

Caspofungin IV - 70mg for 1 day then 50mg daily (70mg if >80kg)

Voriconazole IV-6mg/kg bd for 1 day then 4mg/kg bd

Voriconazole PO – 400mg bd for 1 day then 200mg bd (if <40kg half doses)

Itra conazole liquid - 200mg bd

Fluconazole PO – 50 - 100 mg od

\*Posaconazole – formulation must be stated on prescription

Posa conazole tablets PO – 300 mg bd on day 1 then 300 mg od (treatment and prophylaxis) Posa conazole liquid PO – 200mg tds with meal/fatty food (qds if treatment dose)

Isavuconazole IV/PO – 200 mg tds for 2 days then 200 mg od

Interactions:

Antifungals have many interactions always check patients other medicines and refer to BNF, SPC (www.medicines.org.uk) or consult pharmacist or specialist website -

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Persisting fever and/or not improving

Seek ID/Micro advice

Consider Ambisome IV\*\*

Other options;

-Posaconazole\* (check levels) or Isavuconazole -Caspofungin (if not given initially)
